

Oakville Quilters' Guild Modern Block of the Month 2016/2017 November - Chevrons



Block size: 12.5" unfinished

You will need:

- 2 3" x 6" for three coloured fabrics (total of 6 rectangles)
- 12 3" x 6" background rectangles
- 4.5" x 12.5" background right side
- 2.5" x 12.5" background left side
- A postcard or cardboard with a straight edge, for piecing

We're foundation paper piecing this month. Use whatever technique you prefer, but some basic instructions are below.


Instructions – Piece one A and one B block for each colour


- 1. Print out three copies of the foundations piecing templates. MAKE SURE PAGE SCALING IS SET TO NONE OR ACTUAL SIZE. Cut them out around the outer line.
- 2. Use a smaller stitch on your sewing machine (one step down from normal works well).
- 3. Place your first background piece right side up on the BACK side of the paper template, entirely covering the area marked number 1, the seam allowances and leaving a ¼" overhang onto the number 2 area. Pin in place
- 4. Place your coloured fabric, right sides together, so the edges match along the ¼" overhang. Pin in place, flip over and sew along the line between areas 1 and 2.
- 5. Fold the paper away and trim the seam allowance to ¼" if there's any extra.
- 6. From the top of the paper, align the postcard along the line between area 2 and 3 covering area 2 with the postcard. Fold area 3 back and trim any excess fabric to ¼" from the fold.
- 7. Flip over. Align the next background piece, right sides together, to the newly cut edge, pin in place.
- 8. Flip everything over and sew along the line between areas 2 and 3.
- 9. Repeat for each section (6 in total) and trim along the outer line of the template.
- 10. Piece each chevron pair together, matching points. You can use a pin line up each intersection. Wonder clips or plastic covered paper clips work well instead of pinning the blocks together to avoid distortion.
- 11. Arrange the chevrons as desired and sew together.
- 12. Piece the remaining background strips on each side of the chevron blocks.
- 13. Remove paper from the back of the block.
